Required App/iBook List (Fee & Free) for Sophomores - Fall Semester 2014

The iBook/App Purchasing Process:

All students are required to purchase their own iBooks/Apps for each class. This is necessary as the Apps/iBooks belong to each student's individual Apple ID. Students will purchase these Apps before the start of each semester (fall & spring). All students must have their iBooks/Apps for the Fall Semester (2014) purchased/downloaded by August 18th.

To ensure students/parents are aware of the cost and prepared for the first day, the following information will be distributed to parents/students with report cards and via Email/Mail/Alert System/etc over the summer. Students can purchase their Apps/iBooks well in advance of receiving their iPad in August, as their Apps/iBooks are stored within their Apple Account. (This also includes required Apps that are free). However, students can also wait until receiving their iPad in August to purchase and download necessary Apps/iBooks. (Please see information below about credit card/gift card). Either way, students must have all Apps and iBooks purchased and downloaded to their device by August 18th.

Please refer to the tables below, in order to view the required Apps and iBooks for each class for the Fall 2014 Semester. Each App/iBook is hyperlinked to ensure the correct App/iBook is purchased.

Purchasing iBooks & Apps - Credit Card vs Gift Card

In order to purchase/download Apps/iBooks, <u>students</u> must have a valid credit card or iTunes gift card on their Apple account. <u>We HIGHLY SUGGEST that parents purchase an iTunes Gift Card</u>, to use for redeeming Apps/iBooks for students, instead of putting <u>credit card information on a student's account</u>. Students will NOT be able to download necessary Apps until a valid credit card or gift card has been loaded onto their account.
